

Envelope Bookmarks Psalm 46

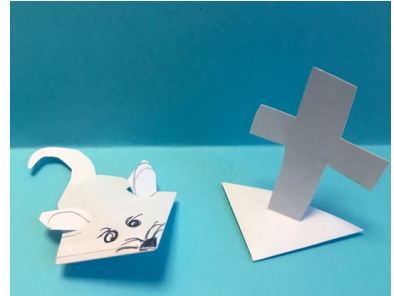

Use envelope corners to make simple bookmarks.

[Optional: Use glue and paper folds instead of envelopes]

Directions: Place pattern on corner of envelope. Trace and cut. On back side cut across the top of the corner triangle. Color and add features to mouse. Slide onto book page corner. Add a message like John 3:16, God loves you, or Shh! Be quiet and listen.

Without envelopes: use patterns with flaps, fold along dotted lines, and glue or tape sides of flaps together. Cross can fold up and stand when reading.



OUTREACH Make these to give out at a group event or to a group of younger children, especially if you are encouraging them to read.

Moisten pointer finger and put inside corner to use as a tiny puppet/
