### Christmas Party Favor Boxes

*How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!* Psalm 119:103

We are to use the gifts God gave us to build up others. We are to show them kindness and love. Use these boxes to remind you to use kind words and give love towards others as you fill them with sweet treats or scriptures.

#### What You Need

Cardstock  
Scissors  
Glue  
Scoring tool (you can use a ruler)  
Marker  
Treats to put inside

#### What to Do

1. Cut the design (candy cane or wreath) from cardstock twice. Decorate as desired.
2. Cut the rectangle with notches from cardstock. This will form the container. Use the 3 inch one for the wreath and the 6 inch one for the candy cane.
3. At  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch in from along each long side, score the rectangle (see dotted lines of pattern). This should be where the notches are on the pattern. Cut out the notches.
4. Make a score across the rectangle between each of the notches along the dotted lines.
5. Score and fold up the scored lines on both sides.
6. Fold and score the remaining two dotted lines. This shapes the container.
7. Put a strong adhesive across the entire outer edge on one side (if you are using a tear tape or tape runner do both of the sides at once before you start attaching them to the lips.)
8. Glue or use double sided tape to adhere the one design on each side of the treat container.
10. After the glue dries fill your container with treats.
