

Easter Booklet Directions

1. Print pattern (the next 2 pages) so the two sides match. The cross of hearts should be on the back of the cover of the booklet.
2. Fold the paper along the solid lines and unfold them.
3. Fold along the center dashed lines. Unfold and fold in half crosswise along center lines Cut along the solid line. Open it up.
4. With the words on the outside, fold the paper in half along the cut opening, lengthwise. Hold the ends and push the pages along the open cut to meet form a booklet. Let the page that says, "My Easter Prayer Book" be on top for the cover.

Page 1 Use colored pencils for best results. Cut the door only on solid lines to form the door with a hinge. Open the door and color the heart cross inside.

Page 2 Color the world

Page 3 Color the sun and the sky around the sun. Cut the door around the sun only along the solid lines. Color the star inside the door and the night sky.

Page 4 Draw tears or sad people. Draw a cross.

Page 5 Cut the stone on the solid line. Then you can open it on the dotted line and see it's empty inside!

Draw flowers outside the tomb.

Page 6 Choose to draw yourself smiling, add your photo, or write thanks to Jesus.

On the back cover write in names of people you want to talk to about Jesus.

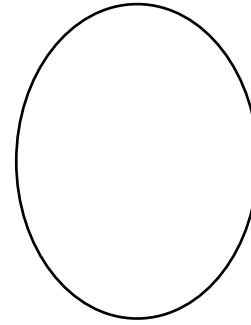

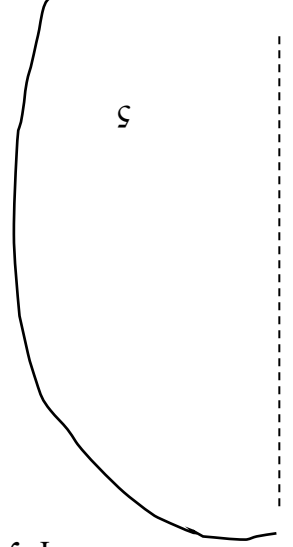

The tomb was empty!

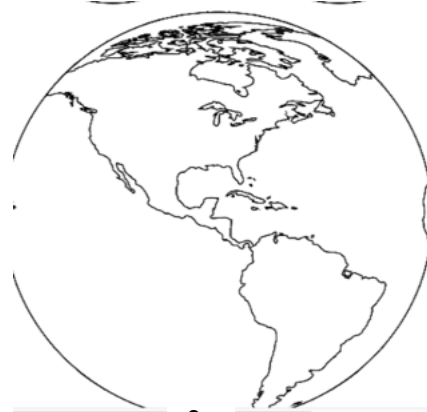

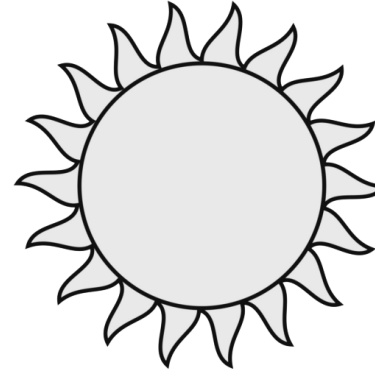
